Location and travel options

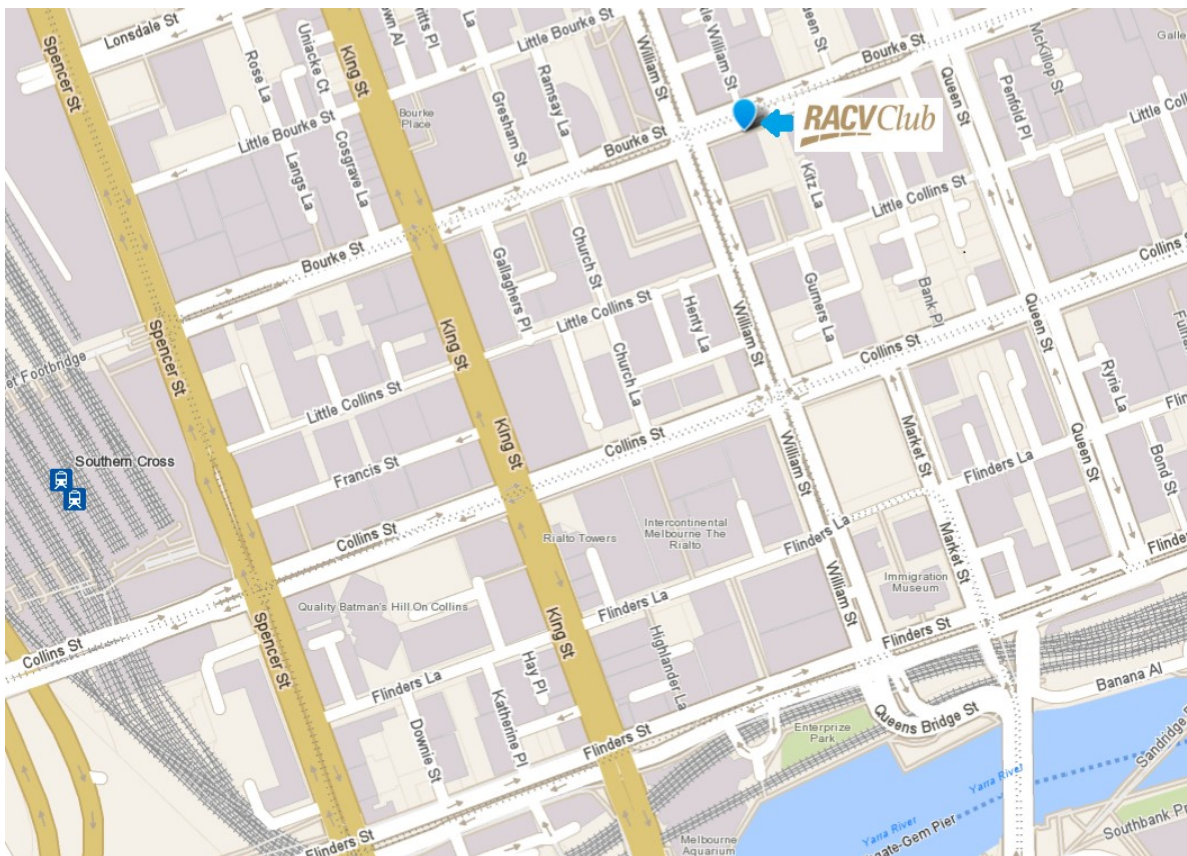
The forum will be at the RACV Club at 501 Bourke Street, Melbourne CBD which is a short walk or tram ride from Southern Cross Station.
